

Finding the Right Program

Determining which kind of program you need is the first order of business. In Katy, we have a full gamut of programs including very part-time church-based preschools to full-day preschool programs within a childcare center. Ask yourself how many days a week will be best for your child – two, three, or every day? Will you need a half day or a full day program? Next, consider what kind of programs will appeal to your kind of child. A shy preschooler, for example, may not be ready to jump into a full-day program in a room with 11 other children. A rambunctious boy with boundless energy may be better suited for a play-based program than one that is focused more on academics.

Ask the Right Questions

After determining your needs, call the preschools to see if they have openings or when registration begins. You will also want to ask about class size, teacher to child ratio, ages of children in the class, dimensions of your child's classroom, and daily activities. After weeding your selections down, you can then set up a time to visit and find out which programs offer enrichment activities best suited to your child.

Check Credentials

If your preschool is offering a special enrichment class such as Tae Kwon Do, ask if an official instructor will be in charge. You'll want to make sure the instructor is CPR and first aid certified. Is a dance instructor teaching the ballet class or does dance class mean running around the room with scarves? One is enrichment; the other is playtime. Also, it's important to find out how much time the enrichment instructor has spent teaching very young children and if they have been background checked and screened thoroughly along with the regular staff.

Choosing a preschool for your little one is an important decision, and while the extra curricular activities shouldn't be the ultimate deciding factor, it certainly is the icing on the cake and can make the days more fun for the kiddos. KM



Many Preschools Offer Dance, Drama, Spanish, Martial Arts, and Other Fun Perks

Primrose Preschools

Primrose Preschools offer gymnastics, dance, Sports Fun, Opus 1, art on Tuesdays, and the option of an extended day. Sports Fun is a popular program that introduces kids to a variety of games and introduces them to the concept of being a good sport and not a sore loser. Opus 1, a music class, exposes children to different kinds of music, encouraging appreciation for music as an art form.

Faith West Academy Preschool

Faith West Academy Preschool is an all-encompassing school, meaning there are no extra costs for all the perks they offer. All of their extra curricular activities are built into their curriculum. "We incorporate creative play, drama, music, role playing, sign language, and Spanish into our classes and as a part of our curriculum everyday to capture our children's imaginations. This allows their learning experiences to be enhanced," says director Seledia Smith. Faith West Academy Preschool is an all day, everyday program. School begins at 8 a.m. and students are released at 2:30 pm.

"CrossPoint Christian School offers an awesome program with great optional afternoon classes," says Missy Geddes, the mother of a preschooler. "As a parent, it's fun to choose a class or classes that fit my child's personality, and it changes the pace in their day," continues Missy.

Director Connie Robinson comments, "In the mornings we offer Spanish and Music and Movement as part of our curriculum. We also have an Eco-Station that currently houses our gardening class where each class has the opportunity to have a special lesson." As



far as extra-curricular activities, which are added to the cost of tuition, CrossPoint offers an array of choices, such as drama, passport fun (geography), art, science club, gardening club, the book beyond (reading club), tumbling and yoga, Espanol solamente (only Spanish), and more.

A Child's Reflection

A Child's Reflection gives parents the option to choose from several enrichment classes, as they are referred to. Their classes include Spanish, music, gym station, sports fun and "You're a Star" dance. The goal of the Spanish program is to promote a good foundation of Spanish and to develop an understanding of language concepts. When a child is introduced to a foreign language at a young age, it's easier for them to learn additional languages in the future. Spanish vocabulary at this young age usually consists of animals, numbers, and colors. All enrichment classes at A Child's Reflection are offered for children ages two and up.

Katy's Early Childhood Enrichment Center


