Finding Joy in the Journey

You can imagine the stares that follow them around wherever they go, especially once they find out, yes - they are all from the same family! Most responses range from "no way" or people automatically think they are doomed to failure, but it is quite the opposite. Colleen says, "Having more children can be difficult but very rewarding. From Utah, to Texas, then off to France, even Australia, and currently in Katy, they haven't let the number of children limit their life experiences, regardless of where they have lived. Airfare alone would cost \$2,500 to \$3,000 dollars for 10 people. The Andersen family has put six children through driver's education, sent eight kids to their first day of kindergarten, watched five graduate high school, kept track of chore charts, laundry, groceries, birthday parties, and car pool without missing a beat. Colleen even makes her own homemade bread and jam, complete with grinding her own wheat.

Keeping it all Together

There's no need to join any playgroups - they have their own. And fancy restaurants aren't necessary either. They create their own with each child planning, cooking, and serving the meal on their assigned evening. There are lists and more lists to keep track of who is doing what, when, where and with whom, and then actually getting them all where they need to be. 

Setting the Tone

An important part of their family dynamic is the fact that all the children are homeschooled until high school. The Bacak's know that regardless of the number of children any family has, setting the tone is important in any family dynamic. Michele says, "The kids pick up on our mood, our reactions, our judgments and sooner or later they are gone so you learn to value those tough times because you know how fast it goes by." So what is the biggest challenge for this family? Communication- making sure everyone is on the same page. Family meetings and giant calendars are helpful tools to make things run smoothly so there is a predictable flow to the family. Michele and Larry agree that you need to set standards early and start young.

The most important thing the Bacaks say they can do for their children is to recognize their temperament and love language. They want to be the kind of parents that respect and understand the personalities they have been given and not change that into what they think works. With their Catholic background, they recognize the value of life and the importance of guiding their children. The latest challenge for this family was Melissa's diagnoses of Down's syndrome. Michele says, "She is God's special gift to us, a channel of grace, who will take us down a different road while enriching our lives."

Family Ties

Both families know the value of time spent together and how quickly it disappears. They have learned to pick their battles and make sacrifices along the way. When things get tough for any family, regardless of size, know that it is only temporary and set your sights on the fantastic blessings that children bring because you blink and they are waving goodbye. There is no doubt that these families wouldn't change a thing about the blessings they have been given and Katy is a better place because they call this town home. **KM**


