

She also has the opportunity to be much more in the public eye, because she's a hostess at our café and gets to use part of her personality that she's very gifted at."

### RICHARD | *Superb Server*

When Richard first came to the Brookwood Community from southern Florida 10 years ago, he had a small social network and group of friends. He was an only child, and his parents, who were retiring, wanted him to connect with others his age. "When he came to the Brookwood Community, Richard was very shy and reticent to be around people," shares DeMunbrun. "What the Brookwood Community brought him was a social construct, just like going off to college."

Now, Richard loves greeting visitors at the Brookwood Café and helps train new café servers. Brookwood is his first full-time employer and he is truly thriving with the responsibility his position requires. He is proud of the chance to help others, and enjoys spreading smiles with his comedic imitations. He brings his good-natured humor to his job, introducing himself to visitors with greetings like, "Welcome to the Brookwood Café. My name is Richard and I will be your best server today."
