Memorial Hermann Katy Hospital Receives Grant for Supportive Medicine Program

The Memorial Hermann Foundation received a \$200,000 grant from the Hearst Foundations to support a systemwide Supportive Medicine Program for chronically ill patients. The goal of the program is to offer home, clinic, and hospital visits by specially trained nurse practitioners or physicians. The teams will work closely to manage each patient's symptoms and medications and connect them with social workers and chaplains to help patients navigate the medical system.

Bryan Cotton, M.D., of Katy, is one of the principal investigators for a nationwide study on traumatic brain injury. The study will be conducted at multiple sites across the country. Cotton will lead the Houston site.

Texas Children's Hospital West Campus Plans to Build Isolation Unit

Texas Children's Hospital West Campus recently announced its plan to build an eight-bed special isolation unit. The unit will be specifically for children with highly contagious infectious diseases, such as pandemic influenza, enterovirus D68, Ebola, and many others. Texas Children's has been designated by the State of Texas as a pediatric Ebola treatment center following a visit from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. The unit will include negative air pressure, laminar air flow, high-efficiency particulate air (HEPA) filtration, separate ventilation, anterooms, biosafety cabinets, a point-of-care laboratory, special security access, autoclaves, and incinerators.

Teddy Bear Clinic

ER Katy hosted a teddy bear clinic for Katy parents and children to bring their stuffed animals to learn how medical tests and procedures are performed. Children learned how doctors listen to breathing with a stethoscope, examine ears and nose with an otoscope, perform an X-ray, and more. The teddy bear clinic is a bimonthly event.
