Art Car Museum

Admission is \$12 per person for adults and children over age 1.

George Observatory

The stars at night really are big and bright - especially when
you're looking through one of the three domed telescopes at
the George Observatory. The observatory is open Saturdays
from 3 to 10 p.m. Park admission is \$7 for adults and

children 12 and under are free. Tickets for the observatory

This 23,000-acre ranch gives city-dwellers the chance to tour homes from the 1800s such as the Jones Stock Farm, the 1860s Ryon Prairie Home, Davis Victorian Complex, and the George Ranch Cattle Complex. Admission is \$10 for adults, \$5 for children ages 5 to 15, and free for kids 4 and under.

Visit the Discovery Room and learn about Houston's urban wildlife that you may not be able to see in the forest. Admission is free for adults and children.
