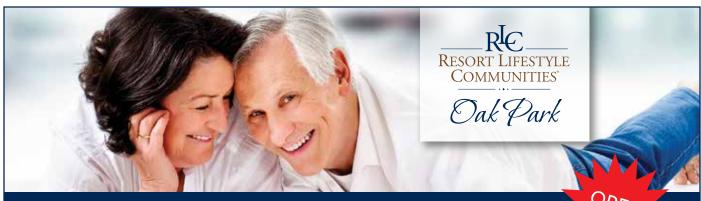
time with my kids and still maintain a form of employment through having my own business from home." - *S.B.*
