Memorial Hermann Katy Hospital Expands Heart and Vascular Services

Memorial Hermann Katy Hospital recently expanded heart and vascular services with the opening of two new cardiac laboratories that can be used for catheter-based procedures as well as electrophysiology procedures. In the new labs, cardiac electrophysiologists can insert pacemakers and perform ablations to treat irregular heartbeats. Specialists can also now offer procedures like removing life-threatening blood clots or inserting stents to help blood flow through arteries via a catheter.

Texas Children's Hospital West Campus Celebrates Sixth Anniversary

Texas Children's Hospital West Campus has proudly served the Katy area for six years. Currently, West Campus is undergoing a three-year, \$50 million expansion project to meet the demand of the rapidly growing west Houston community. Since the expansion began, the hospital has added 10 acute care beds, eight beds dedicated to Texas Children's Special Isolation Unit, built a dedicated interventional radiology suite, and doubled the surgical capacity resulting in 12 preoperative rooms, 22 postoperative recovery beds, and eight operative suites. In addition, current office space has been converted into additional exam rooms to increase outpatient subspecialty access. The next phase of the project will be to complete the 22-bed pediatric intensive care unit (PICU), which is scheduled to open later this year.

AGE-APPROPRIATE SPEECH AND HEARING MILESTONES

While children respond differently at different stages of growth and development, hearing problems may be suspected in children who are not responding to sounds or developing their language skills appropriately. Here are some age-related guidelines:


Birth to 3 months | Reacts to loud sounds, Turns head to you when you speak, Smiles in response to certain voices

4 to 6 months | Looks or turns toward a new sound, Enjoys toys that make sounds, Begins to repeat sounds

7 to 12 months | Responds to his or her own name, Makes babbling sounds, Enjoys games like peek-a-boo and pat-a-cake

1 to 2 years | Says more words as each month passes, Understands simple questions and phrases, Chooses things by size (such as big or little)
