Multitasking Ford Edge

Another addition to Ford's stable of fuel-efficient vehicles is the new Ford Edge. Even though the Edge has been around a few years, the 2012 model year finds a new, even more fuel-efficient power plant under the hood. The updated Edge features an available 2.0-liter Ecoboost four-cylinder engine that boasts 21 miles per gallon city and 30 miles per gallon highway, while producing 240 horsepower. This option does add \$995 to the bottom line, but it is well worth it if you typically keep your vehicle more than two years. And, yes,


the 3.5-liter V-6 still comes standard.

This five-passenger mid-size crossover received a makeover last year and is now one of the sharpest vehicles in the bunch, both inside and out. There have been a lot of grumblings about Ford's driver interface, but we've found the My Ford Touch with Sync very capable. Once mastered, it becomes a great ally in multitasking as you juggle a cell phone call, hauling groceries back to the house, and a back seat full of kiddos screaming for an iPod selection. There are four trim levels to choose from, with pricing starting at \$27,640.

Superb Jeep Grand Cherokee

Completely redesigned last year, the new Jeep Grand Cherokee can now lay claim to no fewer than 30 awards and a sales increase of over 75% compared to the old model. Comparing the 2012 Cherokee to the old model is unfair,





The Grand Cherokee's ride is superb in either the RWD or 4X4 versions, and if you are a serious off-roader, the combination of Grand Cherokee's Quadra-Lift air suspension system and the Jeep Selec-Terrain traction control system lets you choose a 4x4 setting that will have you wondering why folks still buy a Range Rover. on the planet. The 2012 Jeep Grand Cherokee starts at \$26,995.

State-of-the-Art BMW X3

The Spartanburg, South Carolina-built BMW X3 is the second iteration of the model and one of the German company's most popular here in the U.S. Ride and handling are outstanding and the overall design, both inside and out, is state-of-the-art. Fit and finish are also attributes associated with the BMW brand.

BMW's answer to the driver interface is a thing called iDrive, a multifunction knob on the center console that controls audio, GPS, and climate, among other features. A 3.0-liter inline six powers both the 28i and the 35i. A super smooth eight-speed automatic transmission delivers power to a computer-controlled all-wheel drive system. Pricing for the BMW X3 28i begins at \$36,750. KM
