EXEMPLARY RATED SCHOOL

The school first opened in 1989, and during that time, it has been ranked Exemplary by the Texas Education Agency 19 out of 20 years. Earning the highest state ranking a school can receive is just the beginning, though, of campus awards won, honors received, and recognition earned from various state and national agencies.

Pattison was a National Blue Ribbon School, and in the past 10 years it has received the Just for Kids Honor Roll six times, which is a unique award given to elementary schools in Texas for sustained

academic excellence. In 2006, the campus was voted the best among 178 similar elementary schools in the state, making it one of the highest performing elementary schools in the community.

It isn't just about educating the mind, though. Pattison also shows dedication for creating a passion for learning and achieving in each student that will continue on past the fifth grade. Programs such as Reading Empowers All Children (REACH) hone in on specialized skills, polishing the building blocks of a quality education and contributing to the school's mission of providing every student an equal opportunity to learn.
