The iconic theme song for America's favorite pastime also mirrors a way of life for Katy's own baseball star Cliff Archibald, who throws out winning pitches for the Pittsburgh Pirates. As he goes to bat for the minor league team, starting on his second professional season, he keeps his dream of one day playing in the majors in sight. "That could take anywhere from one year to forever," Archibald says. "But I give it my all every day, so that I will be in the majors soon."

Archibald has loved baseball ever since he first picked up a ball when he was 4. He played all through school, making the playoffs during his time at Taylor High School. During his time on the Mustang baseball team, he also played through a back-to-back, no-hitter game.

Road to the Pros

Archibald began his baseball career playing on many Little League teams in the Katy area, later taking the field for the THS Mustangs. He continued his ascent in the baseball world by playing for McClennan Community College in Waco. While in Waco, he learned a lot about himself as a player that still sticks with him today. Prior to attending community college, he had almost quit the sport, initially wanting to play for Baylor University. When they red-shirted him, he turned down the offer, thinking that his baseball career was over.



After one season of playing for MCC, the Pittsburgh Pirates recruited him making him glad that he didn't give up on his dreams. read people. "It's fun to fool people in the game," he says.

His schedule varies or off-season. During the off-season, his day begins at 8 a.m. with eating a well-balanced breakfast and then an extensive two-hour workout. In the afternoon, he practices pitching. season, his day begins earlier at 6 a.m. and he is at the field by 8 a.m. He alternates between workouts and right things is a very pitchers and learns





from their careers. Pitcher Josh Beckett is someone that Archibald has always respected and would like to model his career after.

A Love for the Game

Archibald loves baseball. It's more than his career; it is a hobby and a passion. "I can always be better," he shares. "I can always one-up myself, which makes it a fun challenge." He is appreciative of the support of his family and his hometown of Katy. "Cliff has put a lot of time and work into baseball and it has paid off with the opportunity of a lifetime," says his mother Dee Archibald of Katy. "I am so proud of him for having the courage to pursue his dream."

As a 2009 graduate of THS, he says that the experience on the team greatly contributed to the player he is today. "This is definitely the career for me," he adds. "I love baseball.
