
SOCIAL AND SUPPORT GROUP




Women's ministry at Grace Fellowship UMC. Super Moms does step out of the box, in that each Monday stands on its own. If you can only come every other week or once a month, you are not left out of any discussions. It was designed with busy moms in mind.

Even though every Monday is unique, there is a format that is followed. It brings a bit of stability to the group. Children are dropped off any time after 9:15 a.m. or if child care is not needed it begins at 9:30 a.m. on the 2nd floor of the Epicenter, which is the building next to the child center.

For the first fifteen to twenty minutes women gather and get to know one another. To every Monday there is a speaker assigned.

Topics vary as to whom is speaking. Sometimes there is a testimonial, parenting tips or just a fun devotional and a craft, but God's word is always the center. The second half of the session consists of small group discussion and prayer time where the women have a chance to learn and connect on a deeper level. After her first meeting Lori Grant wrote, "I left there feeling excited about Super Moms, and I can't wait until next Monday. You made everyone feel so welcome."
