Katy ISD Education Foundation

The group established the Alton Frailey Endowment Fund with a donation of \$35,000. The fund will honor the retiring Katy ISD superintendent.

★ Hope Impacts Fundraiser

The charity organization raised over \$5,000 toward their goal of impacting hope in the Katy community helping the homeless and under resourced.

Cinco Ranch Giving Circle
